Olfactory Classification: Ambergris Fragrance Oil belongs to the Aromatic–Oriental fragrance family, characterized by a distinctly warm, elegant, and subtly balsamic profile. The composition combines citrus, floral, and aromatic notes with a warm amber-vanilla base that enhances depth and longevity.

Fragrance Oil Description: The composition is sophisticated, balanced, and elegant, with medium to strong intensity and stable diffusion. The fragrance profile is warm, aromatic, and smooth, with a pronounced sensation of cleanliness and sensory fullness. The opening is formed through a combination of bergamot, rose buds, and geranium. Bergamot provides citrusy freshness with a subtly bitter nuance, rose buds introduce delicate floral elegance, while geranium contributes a green and slightly spicy facet, creating a refined and pleasant first impression.

In the heart of the composition, an aromatic-gourmand accord develops, dominated by verbena leaves, lavender, and tonka bean. Verbena provides refreshing citrus nuances, lavender contributes an aromatic and subtly herbal structure, while tonka bean introduces warm vanilla richness and soft gourmand depth. This combination forms a harmonious and stable heart of the composition.

The base structure is built around vanilla, white cedarwood, and amber. Vanilla provides warmth and enveloping sweetness, white cedarwood contributes a clean and dry woody foundation, while amber introduces resinous depth and lasting performance. The dry-down is elegant, persistent, and pleasant, with a pronounced amber-woody character.

The dominant accords of this composition include aromatic warm, amber resinous, vanilla soft, and woody clean facets, which together create a sophisticated and commercially attractive fragrance profile. Aromatic and amber aspects remain dominant, while the base ensures stability and extended longevity.

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Application: Ambergris Fragrance Oil is intended for use in fragrance formulations, including scented candles, wax applications, and other perfumery products. Individual testing is recommended in order to determine the optimal concentration depending on the type of base and the desired fragrance intensity.

For wax-based formulations, it is recommended to incorporate the fragrance during the appropriate liquid phase in order to achieve even dispersion. For maximum permitted concentrations, consultation of the IFRA certificate is required.

The fragrance demonstrates good stability and uniform diffusion, with a pronounced and long-lasting aromatic-oriental character.
