Together, these notes give the composition a light, airy sophistication and a sense of clarity.

The base structure is built on lemon leaf and musk. Lemon leaf extends the citrus profile through green and slightly bitter nuances, while musk provides a soft, clean, and elegant finish with a smooth sensory depth. The dry-down is refreshing, clean, and long-lasting, with a modern citrus–herbal trail.

The dominant accords of this composition include citrus peel, lemon fresh, green herbal, tea clean, and musky soft facets. The fragrance is especially suited for formulations designed to evoke cleanliness, energy, and a refreshing atmosphere.

Application:

Citrus Zest Fragrance Oil is intended for use in scented candles, wax melts, diffusers,

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and other fragrance formulations. Recommended usage levels are typically 7–10% for candles and 10–15% for wax melts, depending on the desired intensity and type of base. In wax-based formulations, it is recommended to add the fragrance to the liquid wax according to the wax manufacturer's instructions to ensure optimal dispersion and stability. For maximum allowable usage levels, consultation of the IFRA certificate is required. The fragrance demonstrates very good stability and diffusion, with a pronounced and long-lasting citrus–herbal character.
