Olfactory classification:

Coconut Candy Fragrance Oil belongs to the fruity-gourmand fragrance family, with a pronounced sweet, creamy, and candied character. The composition combines red berries, fruit candy, and coconut notes with warm vanilla and sugary accords, creating an intense and playful gourmand olfactory experience.

Fragrance description:

The composition is rich, cheerful, and distinctly sweet, with a strong impression of fruity confections and creamy dessert notes. The fragrance has medium to strong intensity, very good diffusion, and a long-lasting gourmand character.

The opening is built around a combination of wild strawberry, raspberry coulis, and raspberry jelly. Wild strawberry provides a sweet and slightly fresh fruity nuance, while the coulis and jelly add a dense, juicy, almost syrupy fruit richness reminiscent of sweet desserts and candies.

In the heart, notes of strawberry candy, orange blossom, and white peach develop. Strawberry candy delivers a pronounced candied sweetness with a nostalgic confectionery character. Orange blossom adds a soft citrus-floral elegance that brightens the composition, while white peach contributes creamy, velvety fruity softness, rounding out the heart.

The base structure is built on brown sugar, raspberry, vanilla, and coconut. Brown sugar provides warm caramelized sweetness, while raspberry extends the fruity dimension. Vanilla adds creamy gourmand warmth, unifying the composition into a smooth blend, and coconut introduces an exotic milky-cream finish that enhances the tropical dessert character.

The dominant accords of this composition include fruity candy, raspberry jam, creamy vanilla, coconut gourmand, and sugary sweet facets. The fragrance leaves a warm, playful, and intensely sweet trail, ideal for formulations inspired by confectionery, fruit desserts, and tropical themes.

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Application:

Coconut Candy Fragrance Oil is intended for use in scented candles, wax melts, diffusers, and other fragrance formulations. Recommended usage levels are typically 7–10% for candles and 10–15% for wax melts, depending on the desired intensity and type of base. In wax-based formulations, it is recommended to add the fragrance to the liquid wax according to the wax manufacturer's instructions to ensure optimal dispersion and stability. For maximum allowable usage levels, consultation of the IFRA certificate is required. The fragrance demonstrates very good stability and a pronounced gourmand effect in warm and sweet compositions.
