The composition is inspired by honeysuckle blossoms, featuring rich floral nuances, soft honey-like sweetness, and a delicate powdery finish.

Fragrance Oil Description: The composition is elegant, richly floral, and softly honeyed, with a pleasant spring-like character and pronounced floral fullness. The fragrance has a medium intensity, excellent diffusion, and a long-lasting soft floral trail.

The opening of the composition is typically characterized by bright floral and gently fruity nuances that evoke freshness and natural lightness.

At the heart of the fragrance, the honeysuckle accord dominates with distinct nectar-like and honeyed tones. This floral profile provides rich blossom fullness, soft creaminess, and a natural sweetness characteristic of honeysuckle flowers. The composition leaves an elegant and soothing impression with a strong spring-like character.

The base structure is generally soft and slightly powdery, enriched with warm musky and vanilla nuances that further smooth the floral profile and extend the fragrance longevity.

The dominant accords of this composition include floral nectar, sweet honeysuckle, soft white floral, honeyed blossom, and delicate powdery facets. The fragrance leaves a gentle, elegant, and highly pleasant floral trail with natural sweetness and sophisticated floral softness.

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Application: Honeysuckle Fragrance Oil is intended for use in scented candles, wax melts, diffusers, soaps, and other fragrance formulations. The recommended concentration for scented candles is typically between 7–10%, while for wax melts it is 10–15%, depending on the desired intensity and type of base.

For wax-based formulations, it is recommended to add the fragrance to the liquid wax base according to the wax manufacturer's instructions to ensure optimal dispersion and stability. For maximum allowable concentrations, consult the IFRA certificate.

The fragrance oil is manufactured in accordance with European regulations (CLP EC No. 1907/2006 and 1223/2009/CEE) and French IFRA standards.
