Olfactory Classification: Jasmine Fragrance Oil belongs to the white floral, elegant floral, and soft romantic fragrance family, with a pronounced jasmine, floral, and gently powdery character. The composition combines notes of white flowers, freesia, jasmine, orange blossom, and rose, creating a sophisticated and opulent floral fragrance inspired by classic jasmine bouquets.

Fragrance Oil Description: The composition is elegant, richly floral, and sophisticatedly feminine, with a distinct jasmine character and a soft floral finish. The fragrance has a medium to strong intensity, excellent diffusion, and a long-lasting floral trail.

The opening of the composition is based on notes of white flowers and freesia. White flowers provide a bright and airy floral freshness, while freesia adds a subtle spicy nuance and elegant floral lightness.

At the heart of the fragrance, jasmine dominates in its full floral expression. Jasmine delivers a rich, opulent, and intensely floral depth, giving the composition a luxurious and sensual character. The floral profile creates the impression of a sophisticated bouquet with warmth and depth.

The base structure is built around orange blossom and rose. Orange blossom provides a gentle citrus-floral freshness and refined softness, while rose adds a romantic and sophisticated finish that enriches the overall floral character of the composition.

The dominant accords of this fragrance include white floral, jasmine bouquet, soft freesia, orange blossom, and romantic rose profiles. The fragrance leaves an elegant, opulent, and long-lasting floral trail with pronounced floral sophistication.

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Application: Jasmine Fragrance Oil is intended for use in scented candles, wax melts, diffusers, soaps, and other fragrance formulations. The recommended concentration for scented candles typically ranges between 7–10%, while for wax melts it is 10–15%, depending on the desired intensity and type of base.

For wax-based formulations, it is recommended to add the fragrance to the liquid wax base according to the wax manufacturer's instructions to ensure optimal dispersion and stability. For maximum allowable concentrations, consult the IFRA certificate.

The fragrance oil is manufactured in accordance with European regulations (CLP EC No. 1907/2006 and 1223/2009/CEE) and French IFRA standards.
