Product Name: Oud Wood Fragrance Oil

Olfactory Classification: Oud Wood Fragrance Oil belongs to the woody oriental, smoky amber, and oud gourmand fragrance family, characterized by a pronounced woody, resinous, and warm oriental profile. The composition combines notes of bergamot, labdanum (cistus), safranal, Moroccan cedarwood, tonka bean, tobacco, oud, patchouli, and vanilla, creating a rich and sophisticated fragrance inspired by luxurious oriental perfumes.

Description: The composition is deep, elegant, and intensely woody, enriched with distinctive smoky and balsamic nuances. The fragrance exhibits a medium to strong intensity, excellent diffusion, and a long-lasting warm trail. The opening is built around bergamot and cistus. Bergamot provides a radiant citrus freshness with a subtle bitter facet, while cistus introduces resinous amber warmth and rich aromatic depth.

The heart of the fragrance unfolds through notes of safranal, Moroccan cedarwood, and tonka bean. Safranal contributes warm spicy nuances with delicate leathery facets characteristic of saffron, while Moroccan cedarwood provides a dry and elegant woody structure. Tonka bean introduces creamy softness with subtle vanilla and balsamic undertones that soften the intensity of the woody elements.

The base structure is founded on tobacco, oud, patchouli, and vanilla. Tobacco and oud create a dark, smoky, and luxurious foundation with a pronounced oriental character. Patchouli contributes earthy depth and additional complexity, while vanilla rounds out the composition with a warm, soft, and long-lasting finish.

The dominant accords of this composition include oud woody, smoky amber, oriental tobacco, resinous spice, and a warm vanilla profile. The fragrance leaves a rich, sophisticated, and intensely woody trail with an elegant oriental signature.

Application: Oud Wood Fragrance Oil is intended for the manufacture of scented candles, wax melts, reed diffusers, perfumery formulations, and other luxury fragranced products. The recommended concentration for candle formulations generally ranges from 7–10%, while 10–15% is recommended for wax melts,

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depending on the desired fragrance intensity and the type of base used. For wax-based formulations, preliminary testing of fragrance compatibility and performance is recommended to ensure optimal stability and diffusion. For maximum permitted concentrations, the relevant IFRA Certificate should be consulted. The fragrance demonstrates excellent substantivity and a pronounced woody-oriental character.

Oud Wood Fragrance Oil is manufactured in accordance with European regulations (CLP Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 and 1223/2009/EC) and French IFRA standards.
