Product Name: Poppy Fragrance Oil

Olfactory Classification: Poppy Fragrance Oil belongs to the floral fruity, powdery floral, and soft musky fragrance family, characterized by a pronounced floral, powdery, and delicately fruity profile. The composition combines notes of poppy, apple, hyacinth, blackcurrant, violet, jasmine, rose, sandalwood, musk, and raspberry, creating an elegant and romantic fragrance inspired by blooming poppy fields.

Description: The composition is delicate, floral, and elegantly powdery, enriched with distinct floral facets and subtle fruity nuances. The fragrance exhibits a medium intensity, excellent diffusion, and a long-lasting soft trail. The opening is built around poppy, apple, hyacinth, and blackcurrant. Poppy imparts a light floral freshness with natural green nuances, while apple contributes crisp fruity freshness and gentle sweetness. Hyacinth introduces a more pronounced spring floral character, while blackcurrant provides a subtly tart fruity depth that enhances the opening notes.

The heart of the fragrance unfolds through notes of violet, jasmine, and rose. Violet contributes powdery elegance and floral softness, while jasmine introduces a richer, more exotic floral depth. Rose lends a sophisticated and romantic character that completes the floral structure of the composition.

The base structure is founded on sandalwood, musk, and raspberry. Sandalwood provides creamy woody warmth and a soft foundation, while musk contributes a clean and sensual finish. Raspberry introduces a delicate fruity sweetness that adds a light and refreshing accent to the dry-down.

The dominant accords of this composition include powdery floral, soft poppy bloom, romantic rose, fruity musk, and a creamy sandalwood profile. The fragrance leaves a delicate, elegant, and sophisticated floral trail with a soft powdery character.

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Application: Poppy Fragrance Oil is intended for the manufacture of scented candles, wax melts, reed diffusers, air fresheners, and other fragranced formulations. The recommended concentration for wax-based formulations generally ranges from 7–10%, while 10–15% is recommended for wax melts, depending on the desired fragrance intensity and the type of base used. For wax-based formulations, preliminary testing of fragrance compatibility and performance is recommended to ensure optimal stability and diffusion. For maximum permitted concentrations, the relevant IFRA Certificate should be consulted. The fragrance demonstrates excellent stability and a pronounced floral-powdery character.
