Olfactory Classification: Relaxation in Tahiti Fragrance Oil belongs to the tropical floral, marine coconut, and soft musky fragrance family, characterized by an exotic, marine, and creamy-warm profile. The composition combines notes of ylang-ylang, heliotrope, marine accord, musk, and coconut, creating a relaxing tropical fragrance inspired by the atmosphere of Tahitian beaches and exotic spa rituals.

Description: The composition is exotic, delicately floral, and refreshingly marine, enriched with pronounced tropical and creamy nuances. The fragrance exhibits a medium intensity, pleasant diffusion, and a soft, long-lasting trail. The opening is built around ylang-ylang and heliotrope. Ylang-ylang delivers rich exotic florality with a subtle sensual character and warm floral nuances, while heliotrope contributes powdery softness and delicately sweet facets reminiscent of sun-kissed blossoms.

At the heart of the composition, a marine accord unfolds, introducing crystal-clear freshness with a subtle salty character inspired by ocean air and rolling sea waves. This accord imparts a sense of open space, tropical breezes, and a refreshing seaside atmosphere.

The base structure is founded on musk and coconut. Musk provides a clean, soft, and sensual character that enhances the longevity of the composition, while coconut contributes creamy tropical richness and a warm exotic finish. The dry-down is soothing, pleasantly warm, and evocative of luxurious tropical spa environments.

The dominant accords of this composition include tropical coconut, marine freshness, exotic florals, soft musk, and a powdery heliotrope profile. The fragrance leaves a relaxing, clean, and elegantly tropical trail.

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Application: Relaxation in Tahiti Fragrance Oil is intended for the manufacture of scented candles, wax melts, reed diffusers, and other fragranced formulations. It is particularly suitable for spa collections, summer fragrances, and tropical ambient products thanks to its balanced marine and coconut character. The recommended concentration depends on the type of base and the desired fragrance intensity. For wax-based formulations, preliminary testing of compatibility and fragrance diffusion is recommended. For maximum permitted concentrations, the relevant IFRA Certificate should be consulted.
