Product Name: Roasted Chestnut Fragrance Oil

Olfactory Classification: Roasted Chestnut Fragrance Oil belongs to the gourmand woody, roasted nut, and warm smoky fragrance family, characterized by a warm, creamy, and subtly smoky profile. The composition combines notes of roasted chestnut, heliotrope, smoky accords, almond, and sandalwood, creating a rich and comforting fragrance inspired by autumn and winter atmospheres.

Description: The composition is warm, creamy, and distinctly gourmand, featuring prominent roasted nut facets and delicate smoky nuances. The fragrance exhibits a medium to strong intensity, excellent longevity, and a rich, warm projection. The opening is built around notes of chestnut and freshly roasted chestnut. These notes provide a full-bodied, nutty, and subtly caramelized character reminiscent of the aroma of freshly roasted chestnuts enjoyed during cool autumn and winter days. The opening impression is indulgently gourmand, warm, and naturally rich.

The heart of the composition unfolds through heliotrope and a smoky accord. Heliotrope contributes powdery florality with delicate vanilla and almond nuances, softening the intensity of the top notes while adding elegant creamy depth. The smoky accord evokes the warmth of burning wood and the subtle scent of a fireplace, creating a comforting sense of coziness and a welcoming atmosphere.

The base structure is founded on almond and sandalwood. Almond further enhances the gourmand nutty character of the composition, while sandalwood contributes creamy woody richness and a soft, warm finish that extends the longevity of the fragrance.

The dominant accords of this composition include roasted chestnut, warm nuts, soft smoke, creamy sandalwood, and a powdery heliotrope profile. The fragrance leaves a rich, warm, and pleasantly soothing trail with a distinctive autumn-winter character.

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Application: Roasted Chestnut Fragrance Oil is intended for the manufacture of scented candles, wax melts, reed diffusers, and other fragranced formulations. It is particularly suitable for autumn and winter collections thanks to its warm gourmand and smoky character. The recommended concentration depends on the type of base and the desired fragrance intensity, while preliminary testing of compatibility and fragrance diffusion is recommended for wax-based formulations. For maximum permitted concentrations, the relevant IFRA Certificate should be consulted.
