The opening is based on a dynamic combination of orange, lemon, bergamot, and petitgrain. The citrus notes provide pronounced freshness and subtle tart vibrancy, while petitgrain introduces delicate woody-green nuances. Bergamot contributes sophistication, giving the composition a slight bitterness and additional depth.

In the heart of the fragrance, a refined floral accord develops, dominated by neroli, white flowers, and rose. Neroli provides a clean and luminous floral note with pronounced elegance. White flowers contribute fullness and softness, while rose introduces classic floral harmony and a subtle romantic dimension, creating a balanced and recognizable central accord.

The base structure is built around musk and cedarwood. Musk provides softness, stability, and longevity, while cedarwood creates a dry woody foundation that rounds out the composition and enhances its lasting character. The dry-down is warm and clean, with gentle woody depth supporting the citrus-floral profile of the fragrance.

Dominant accords of this composition include citrus fresh, floral elegant, musky soft, and woody clean profiles, which together create a harmonious and commercially attractive fragrance character. The citrus aspect provides energy and freshness, the floral heart adds elegance and recognizability, while the musky-woody base ensures stability and long-lasting performance.

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Application:

Romance in Portofino Fragrance Oil is intended for broad use in fragranced formulations, including candles, wax melts, and other perfumery compositions, where dosage should be adjusted according to the desired fragrance intensity. It is recommended to perform individual testing in order to optimize concentration depending on the type of base and desired sensory effect.
