Product Name: 109 Candle Fragrance Oil.

Olfactory classification: 109 Fragrance Oil belongs to the citrus aromatic, spicy woody and amber fragrance groups, with a pronounced citrus, herbal, spicy and woody character. The composition combines notes of orange, mandarin, pink pepper, grapefruit, lavender, anise, apple, nutmeg, vetiver, patchouli, cedarwood and amber, creating a dynamic fragrance with a bright citrus-spicy opening, an aromatic heart and a deep woody-amber base.

Fragrance oil description: The composition is fresh, energetic and distinctly aromatic, with citrus and spicy nuances that gradually transition into a warm, dry and rich woody base. The fragrance has medium-strong to strong intensity, very good diffusion and a long-lasting, sophisticated trail. The opening is built around orange, mandarin, pink pepper and grapefruit. Orange and mandarin provide juicy citrus sweetness, while pink pepper introduces vibrant, subtly fruity and spicy piquancy. Grapefruit contributes a fresh, bitter-citrus character, further accentuating the energy of the opening notes. Lavender, anise, apple and nutmeg develop in the heart of the fragrance. Lavender provides a clean herbal-floral character, while anise contributes a sweet and distinctively aromatic nuance. Apple introduces crisp fruity freshness, and nutmeg adds a warm, dry and subtly woody spicy note. The base is built around vetiver, patchouli, cedarwood and amber. Vetiver provides dry, earthy and woody depth, while cedarwood contributes a firm and elegant woody structure. Patchouli enriches the base with darker earthy nuances, and amber rounds out the composition with warm balsamic fullness and extended longevity. The dominant accords include sparkling citrus, pink pepper, aromatic lavender, anise, warm spices, vetiver, cedar, patchouli and warm amber. The fragrance leaves a fresh, powerful and sophisticated aromatic-woody impression.

Applications: 109 Fragrance Oil is intended for the manufacture of scented candles, wax melts, diffusers, air fresheners and other fragranced formulations. It is particularly suitable for citrus-aromatic, woody, spicy, fougère and ambery collections. The recommended concentration depends on the type of base and the desired fragrance intensity, subject to prior compatibility, stability and diffusion testing. The relevant IFRA Certificate should be consulted to determine the maximum permitted concentrations.
