Product Name: 206 Candle Fragrance Oil.

Olfactory classification: 206 Fragrance Oil belongs to the floral gourmand, oriental balsamic and creamy woody fragrance groups, with a pronounced floral, chocolate, vanilla and warm woody character. The composition combines notes of coffee, orange blossom, mandarin, gardenia, chocolate, tuberose, vanilla, sandalwood and ambergris, creating an opulent fragrance with a contrasting citrus-coffee opening, an intense floral-gourmand heart and a warm, creamy base.

Fragrance oil description: The composition is rich, opulent and intensely gourmand, with dominant white florals, chocolate nuances and a warm oriental-woody finish. The fragrance has pronounced intensity, rich diffusion and a long-lasting, sensual trail. The opening is built around coffee, orange blossom and mandarin. Coffee provides a deep, aromatic and pleasantly bitter nuance, while orange blossom introduces bright floral sweetness. Mandarin contributes juicy citrus freshness and creates a contrast with the darker character of coffee. Gardenia, chocolate and tuberose develop in the heart of the fragrance. Gardenia provides a rich, creamy white-floral character, while tuberose contributes intense, opulent and intoxicating florality. Chocolate connects these floral notes with a pronounced gourmand accord, giving the composition sweet, warm and almost creamy fullness. The base is built around vanilla, sandalwood and ambergris. Vanilla provides warm, creamy gourmand sweetness, while sandalwood contributes soft woody fullness. Ambergris rounds out the composition with warm, mineral-amber and subtly marine nuances, giving the base additional depth and longevity. The dominant accords include roasted coffee, orange blossom, white florals, dark chocolate, creamy vanilla, sandalwood and ambergris. The fragrance leaves an opulent, warm and sophisticated floral-gourmand impression.

Applications: 206 Fragrance Oil is intended for the manufacture of scented candles, wax melts, diffusers, air fresheners and other fragranced formulations. It is particularly suitable for floral gourmand, oriental, chocolate, vanilla and woody collections. The recommended concentration depends on the type of base and the desired fragrance intensity, subject to prior compatibility, stability and diffusion testing. The relevant IFRA Certificate should be consulted to determine the maximum permitted concentrations.
