Product Name: 209 Candle Fragrance Oil.

Olfactory classification: 209 Fragrance Oil belongs to the fruity floral, soft woody and white musk fragrance groups, with a pronounced fruity, floral and creamy-woody character. The composition combines notes of raspberry, lychee, freesia, ylang-ylang, peony, rose, patchouli, white musk and white sandalwood, creating a sophisticated fragrance with a juicy fruity-floral opening, an opulent floral heart and a soft woody-musky base.

Fragrance oil description: The composition is elegant, feminine and opulently floral, with juicy fruity nuances and a soft, creamy-woody finish. The fragrance has pronounced intensity, good diffusion and a long-lasting, sophisticated trail. The opening is built around raspberry, lychee and freesia. Raspberry provides a juicy, sweet-tart fruity nuance, while lychee contributes exotic, watery and subtly sweet freshness. Freesia introduces an airy and clean floral character, linking the fruity notes with the floral heart of the composition. Ylang-ylang, peony and rose develop in the heart of the fragrance. Ylang-ylang provides rich, exotic and subtly creamy florality, while peony contributes a fresh, delicate and airy floral character. Rose introduces classic floral depth and rounds out the heart into a harmonious, opulent floral bouquet. The base is built around patchouli, white musk and white sandalwood. Patchouli provides earthy and woody depth, while white musk contributes clean, silky softness. White sandalwood rounds out the composition with creamy and warm woody nuances, giving the fragrance a long-lasting and elegant finish. The dominant accords include juicy raspberry, exotic lychee, airy freesia, peony and rose, ylang-ylang, white musk and creamy sandalwood. The fragrance leaves an elegant, sophisticated and distinctly fruity-floral impression.

Applications: 209 Fragrance Oil is intended for the manufacture of scented candles, wax melts, diffusers, air fresheners and other fragranced formulations. It is particularly suitable for fruity floral, floral, soft woody and white musk collections. The recommended concentration depends on the type of base and the desired fragrance intensity, subject to prior compatibility, stability and diffusion testing.
