Product Name: 212 Fragrance Oil.

Olfactory classification: 212 Fragrance Oil belongs to the floral gourmand, coffee floral and creamy woody fragrance groups, with a pronounced floral, gourmand and warm creamy-woody character. The composition combines notes of coffee, orange blossom, mandarin, gardenia, chocolate, tuberose, vanilla, sandalwood and ambergris, creating an opulent fragrance with a contrasting coffee and citrus opening, a rich white-floral heart and a warm, creamy base.

Fragrance oil description: The composition is rich, sensual and distinctly floral-gourmand, with a recognisable coffee accord, opulent white flowers and a warm, creamy-woody finish. The fragrance has medium to high intensity, very good diffusion and a long-lasting sophisticated trail. The opening is built around coffee, orange blossom and mandarin. Coffee provides a deep, aromatic and subtly bitter nuance, while orange blossom contributes bright and sweet floral fullness. Mandarin introduces juicy citrus freshness that illuminates the darker character of the coffee and creates an expressive contrast in the opening. Gardenia, chocolate and tuberose unfold in the heart. Gardenia and tuberose form an opulent, creamy and intense white-floral accord, while chocolate introduces warm gourmand sweetness and additional fullness. Their combination gives the composition a rich, sensual and almost velvety heart. The base is built around vanilla, sandalwood and ambergris. Vanilla provides creamy, warm sweetness, while sandalwood contributes soft woody depth and roundness. Ambergris introduces a subtle ambery-marine character and additional longevity, creating an elegant and lasting finish. The dominant accords include roasted coffee, orange blossom, white florals, tuberose, chocolate gourmand, creamy vanilla, sandalwood and ambergris. The fragrance leaves a rich, warm and sophisticated floral-gourmand impression.

Applications: 212 Fragrance Oil is intended for the manufacture of scented candles, wax melts, diffusers, air fresheners and other fragranced formulations. It is particularly suitable for floral gourmand, coffee, white floral, chocolate and creamy woody collections. The recommended concentration depends on the type of base and the desired fragrance intensity, subject to prior compatibility, stability and diffusion testing. The relevant IFRA Certificate should be consulted to determine the maximum permitted concentrations.
