Product Name: 216 Candle Fragrance Oil.

Olfactory classification: 216 Fragrance Oil belongs to the spicy floral, amber oriental and resinous woody fragrance groups, with a pronounced spicy, floral and warm balsamic character. The composition combines notes of coriander, plum, spices, orange blossom, rose, tuberose, carnation, cinnamon, amber, sandalwood, opoponax and musk, creating a rich and sophisticated fragrance with an opulent floral heart and a deep oriental base.

Fragrance oil description: The composition is intense, elegant and distinctly oriental, with warm spicy nuances, a rich floral heart and a resinous-woody finish. The fragrance has medium to high intensity, very good diffusion and a long-lasting, sophisticated trail. The opening is built around coriander, plum, spicy notes and orange blossom. Coriander provides subtle citrus-spicy freshness, while plum contributes a soft, darker fruity character. Warm spices introduce pronounced aromatic depth, while orange blossom illuminates the composition with delicate citrus-floral freshness. Rose, tuberose, carnation and cinnamon unfold in the heart. Rose provides rich and elegant floral fullness, while tuberose contributes an intense, creamy and intoxicating floral character. Carnation introduces a peppery, spicy nuance, while cinnamon provides warmth and further accentuates the composition's oriental profile. The base is built around amber, sandalwood, opoponax and musk. Amber provides warm balsamic fullness and sensual depth, while sandalwood contributes creamy woody warmth. Opoponax introduces rich resinous and subtly sweet nuances, while musk rounds out the composition with a soft and long-lasting trail. The dominant accords include spicy floral, warm amber, creamy tuberose, resinous opoponax and soft musk. The fragrance leaves a rich, warm and distinctly sophisticated oriental impression.

Applications: 216 Fragrance Oil is intended for the manufacture of scented candles, wax melts, diffusers, air fresheners and other fragranced formulations. It is particularly suitable for oriental, spicy, floral and amber-resinous collections. The recommended concentration depends on the type of base and the desired fragrance intensity, subject to prior compatibility, stability and diffusion testing. The relevant IFRA Certificate should be consulted to determine the maximum permitted concentrations.
