Product Name: 222 Fragrance Oil.

Olfactory classification: 222 Fragrance Oil belongs to the floral oriental, woody oud and creamy musk fragrance groups, with a pronounced floral, resinous-woody and warmly sensual character. The composition combines notes of lily of the valley, bergamot, cyclamen, liquorice, rose, oud, vanilla, musk and sandalwood, creating a sophisticated fragrance with an elegant floral opening and a rich oriental base.

Fragrance oil description: The composition is elegant, deep and distinctly oriental, with a fresh floral opening, a rich woody heart and a creamy finish. The fragrance has medium to high intensity, very good diffusion and a long-lasting, sophisticated trail. The opening is built around lily of the valley, bergamot and cyclamen. Lily of the valley provides delicate, clean and airy floral freshness, while bergamot introduces citrus clarity with a subtly bitter nuance. Cyclamen contributes an elegant floral character with discreetly spicy and watery tones, creating a dynamic and appealing introduction. Liquorice, rose and oud unfold in the heart. Liquorice provides characteristic aniseed sweetness and darker aromatic depth, while rose contributes rich, velvety floral fullness and classic elegance. Oud introduces a powerful woody-resinous character and exotic richness, giving the heart pronounced depth and sophistication. The base is built around vanilla, musk and sandalwood. Vanilla contributes warm creamy sweetness and soft fullness, while musk provides a velvety and sensual trail. Sandalwood rounds out the composition with rich creamy-woody warmth and extends its persistence. The dominant accords include floral freshness, liquorice rose, resinous oud, creamy vanilla and soft sandalwood. The fragrance leaves a rich, warm and elegantly oriental trail.

Applications: 222 Fragrance Oil is intended for the manufacture of scented candles, wax melts, diffusers, air fresheners and other fragranced formulations. It is particularly suitable for luxurious floral-oriental, oud and woody-musky collections. The recommended concentration depends on the type of base and the desired fragrance intensity, subject to prior compatibility, stability and diffusion testing. The relevant IFRA Certificate should be consulted to determine the maximum permitted concentrations.
